

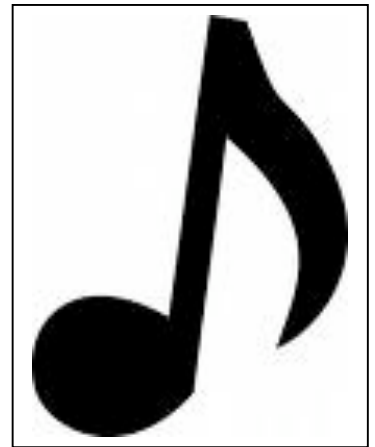

Q4 MUSIC TOPICS

- Echo singing with basic solfege patterns
- High and low in music—introduction to Grade 1 rhythms
- Short and long sounds—how many sounds are on one beat
- Same and different in music
- Mood in music

BRINGING THE MUSIC HOME

1. Our last two songs from this year's theme, ROOTED IN CHRIST, focus on Colossians 2:6, 7, 19. God grows spiritual fruit in our lives! And he asks us to share what He has freely given. Sing the Q4 songs with your student. Take time to talk about the spiritual fruit in your life and how you share that with God's people.
2. Play a version of "Simon Says" where players are only allowed to move when two clapped patterns are the same. Try homemade instruments or two wooden spoons to tap the patterns. Practice critical listening skills with your young musician when you turn on the radio or sing in the car.
